



## How to enrol, update, or change rolls.

## Māori mā, if you're 18 or older and enrolling for the first time, you choose which roll to be on: the Māori roll or the general roll.

You can choose to change the roll you're on for this year's local elections until **midnight 10 July**. The roll you choose may affect who you can vote for in these elections.

Changing rolls, enrolling, or updating your details is easy!



Go to **vote.nz** to do it online using your driver licence, passport or RealMe verified identity.

Complete, sign, and return an enrolment form. You don't need ID to do this. You can submit it by uploading, emailing, or posting it back to us.



Complete a form online and have it emailed or posted to you to sign and return.



Print and complete a form.
